

Dues

Dues for Awana this year are 75 cents each week and are used to help pay for awards and supplies. You will give your dues to the leaders taking roll at the check-in tables. If you wish to pay for the entire year, the cost is \$22.00 for the first clubber, \$20.00 for the second, and \$18.00 for the third clubber.

Awana Guidelines

In order to have a safe, enjoyable and orderly environment, our club has established these guidelines. All clubbers are expected to follow them.

1. Respect your fellow club members and leaders at all times.
2. You must remain on the church grounds at all times.
3. You must cooperate and obey the Awana leaders.
4. A Canyon Del Oro Baptist Church Awana Leader is the only person allowed to “sign” a handbook section.
5. Leave all food and drinks at home (including gum), except where provided by your leader.
6. Bring your Awana handbook every week.
7. As soon as you earn your uniform, wear it every week to club.
8. Wear closed-toe shoes suitable for running.
9. Please take care of the church property and equipment.
10. Have a good time.

Discipline

Awana clubbers are called to order by use of the five-count. This teaches and encourages acceptable group behavior. If a child misbehaves or is overly disruptive, the club leader or director may choose to use a three-count. This is an individual approach in which the child is given two more warnings. If there is a third offence, the clubber will be taken to the Commander to discuss the problem, and to determine if further disciplinary action is necessary.
